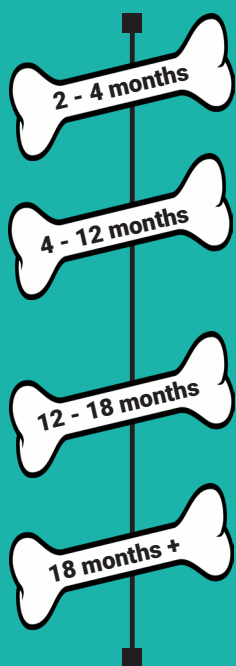

UDS Service Dogs are trained from puppies for two years by a team of expert professionals and dedicated volunteers. We have a critical need to raise and train more puppies each year so that they can be placed with individuals who have mobility or support needs, or into facilities such as schools where they provide affection, comfort and love to many students, staff and families.

## Life Of A Service Dog In Training



Puppies are raised in a volunteer home.

Puppies enter the life-changing Pups in Prison Program. Inmates at the Houtzdale State Correctional Institution continue the training journey until the puppies are one year old.

When the dogs return to UDS, they are again placed with a volunteer home to begin intermediate training.

At 18 months old, they begin their final phase of training at our UDS facility. Our specialized professional trainers work with the dogs to enhance the skills needed in preparation for their placement.



## You Can Change A Life Today

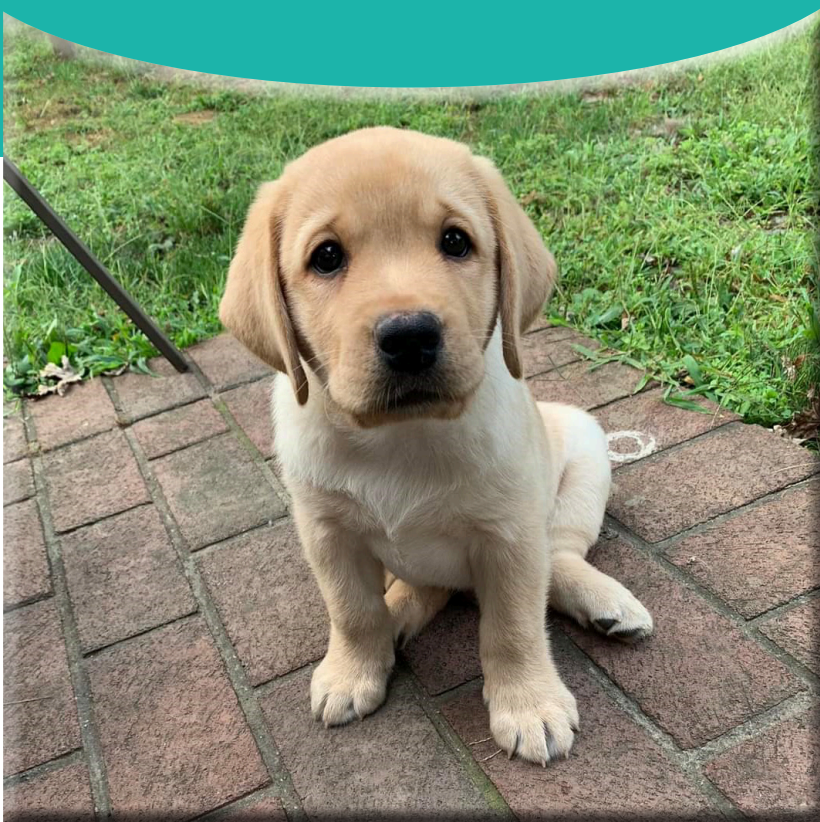
With your support, our puppies can continue to fulfill the UDS mission to enhance abilities and change lives, while becoming lifelong companions and friends to those they serve.
